AN ORDINANCE AMENDING:

**CHAPTER 6 – BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION
OF THE
OAKWOOD HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
OAKWOOD HILLS, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. Change: Section R337.1.2 and 3115.2. Allowed fences.

FROM:

R337.1.2 and 3115.2 Allowed fences. No fence shall be erected in the Village unless it is one of the following types: vinyl, split rail, basket weave, chain link, post and rail, or any other type of fence design constructed of wood.

TO:

R337.1.2 and 3.115.2 Allowed fences.

A fence is defined as: A structure, not part of a building, forming a physical barrier, designed and intended as an enclosure, barrier, or boundary and to restrict or prevent movement across a boundary, for protection, privacy or confinement of an area.

An allowed fence is defined as: A fence constructed of one of the following: vinyl, split rail, basket weave, chain link, post and rail, metal or any other type of fence design constructed of wood. No fence shall be erected in the Village unless it is made of the approved materials listed.

2. Add to Chapter 6, Section 6-201.2, R202 Definitions as follows:

FENCE: A structure, not part of a building, forming a physical barrier, designed and intended as an enclosure, barrier, or boundary and to restrict or prevent movement across a boundary, for protection, privacy or confinement of an area.

3. Add to Chapter 6, Section 6-301, Section 202 Definitions as follows:

FENCE: A structure, not part of a building, forming a physical barrier, designed and intended as an enclosure, barrier, or boundary and to restrict or prevent movement across a boundary, for protection, privacy or confinement of an area.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions thereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
