

## **Salt Shortage Update**

Nunda Township has agreed to help us with our salt shortage. We have to make sure the streets are clear of snow and then they will come out to salt the hilly roads in town. Since they have to conserve their supply of salt, the flat areas of the village will remain unsalted and just plowed. There is a fee for them to come out and salt for us so we have to be careful of our expenditure and make sure that it is an absolute necessity.

Please be cautious at intersections where snow is piled high and visibility of oncoming traffic may be partially obstructed. This is a problem throughout the county.

We are keeping a careful eye on another winter storm due to hit this weekend: Possible freezing rain turning to snow with a chance of a large accumulation of snow. Please plan ahead for shopping and running any important errands so you can stay off the roads when the storm hits. This is just good practice for any bad weather forecasts.

I have had several calls from our snowplow driver that people are parking on the roads during snowstorms. It is impossible for them to clear the roads if people are parked on the roadways. You also risk the chance that your vehicle could be damaged by the plow. There are signs posted in the village that you cannot park when snow is accumulating. **YOU MUST** move your vehicle or get ticketed. Right now we don't tow, but that might not be the case in the future so please get used to parking in your driveways or garage when it's snowing.

## **Update on the Village Hall**

During the extreme cold weather in January we had a pipe burst in the Village Hall. It damaged everything but the police department. Since that time we have had to demo and then replace everything that was damaged. Our insurance is covering the cost for everything that needed to be done. We are sorry for any inconvenience it may have caused for our residents. \* Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup> it will be completed.
